Code of Conduct & Disciplinary Procedures Blueprint

1. Sportsmanship & Court Standards

• **Fair Play:** High standards of tennis etiquette and honesty on line calls are required. Benefit of the doubt always goes to the opponent/receiver. • **Respectful Environment:** Verbal abuse, profanity, racket throwing, or aggressive behavior toward opponents, teammates, or facility staff is strictly prohibited. • **Spectator Guidelines:** Spectators must observe from designated viewing areas outside the court fences and maintain positive, respectful support without interfering in line calls or scoring.

2. Dispute Escalation & Formal Protests

• **On-Court Resolution:** In scoring disputes, players must revert to the last agreed-upon score. Never replay completed games. • **Captain Intervention:** If an on-court issue cannot be resolved calmly by players, both team captains must step in before play proceeds. • **Formal Match Protest:** Captains may submit a formal written protest through the mobile app to the League Coordinator within 24 hours of match completion.

3. Disciplinary Actions & Penalties

• **First Infraction:** Formal written warning issued to the player and recorded with the team captain. • **Second Infraction:** One-match suspension and forfeiture of individual court points for that fixture. • **Severe / Repeated Violations:** Roster expulsion without refund, subject to League Committee review.
